

PLAYOFF RULES:

Playoffs will begin March 15th

The top 4 teams will compete in playoffs. The first round is 1 v 4, 2 v 3, last weeks standings showed the wrong information.

If a team only has 4 players for the playoffs they must play a ghost in the 5th spot, they may not have a player play 2 spots.

Playoffs will be played on the 15 game format used at the state tournament and will be handicapped. The team with the most points wins, not by matches won. In case of a tie then you will play one game using the scotch doubles format with all members of the team. You must play the order on the score sheet starting with the first player and going down.

The “8 on break” tournament rule is in effect for the playoffs.
This rule states: “The breaker may ask for a rerack or have the 8-ball spotted and continue shooting. Should the breaker pocket the 8-ball and scratch, the incoming player has the option of spotting the 8-ball and shooting from behind the headstring or reracking and assuming the break. A game cannot be won or lost with an 8-ball on the break, regardless of what is pocketed on the same shot.”

This rule is in addition to the regular rules.

All players in the playoff must have 20 games played during the current season to qualify for playoffs.

There WILL BE league fees during playoffs will all monies going back into prize fund. Any teams that do not pay their league fees for playoffs will have it deducted from their end of season winnings.
